VOTER QUALIFICATIONS

To be eligible to vote a person must be:

- 18 years of age on the day of the election
- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Colorado and the precinct
- Registered to vote on or before the registration deadline (29 days prior to the election)

Change of Address: Notification of change of address may be made by mail or in person at any registration site until 30 days before an election; after that time, including Election Day, notification must be made in person at the Denver Elections Division office.

WHEN ELECTIONS ARE HELD

General Election: The first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in **even-numbered years**.

General election includes: Presidential, Congressional, State Legislature, State Board of Education, CU Regents, RTD Board of Directors, and Denver District Attorney candidates. Also on the ballot: retention of Court of Appeals, District and County judges and any state or municipal initiative, referendum, or other referred measures.

Last day to register: 29 days prior to election day.

Early Voting starts 15 days before scheduled election. Locations will be mailed to registered voters or may be found on the website.

Odd-Numbered Year Elections: The first Tuesday in November in odd-numbered years. These elections include: Denver School board candidates and any initiative referendum, charter amendments or other referred measures to be voted on.

Denver Municipal Elections: The first Tuesday in May of odd-numbered years: city office vacancy candidates and/or any initiative, referendum, charter amendments or other referred measures to be voted on.

Party Primary: The second Tuesday in August in even-numbered years. Unaffiliated voters may declare a party affiliation on Primary election day.

PRECINCT CAUCUSES

When: The third Tuesday in March of even-numbered years.

To vote in a precinct caucus a person must have been affiliated with a political party for two months and have been a resident in the precinct for 30 days prior to the caucus date.

MAIL-IN VOTING

Any registered voter may request a mail-in ballot for any or all elections.

- Mail-in ballot application forms may be requested from the Denver Elections Division in person, by mail, phone or downloaded from the website.
- Mail-in ballot application forms may be requested from the Denver Elections Division until the Tuesday before the election if it is to be mailed; the Friday before the election if it will be picked up.
- If a mail-in ballot is requested, it must be used to vote; one cannot then go to the polls to vote.

In the event that a **mail-in ballot is lost or damaged**, you may request a replacement ballot from the Elections Division or you may cast a **provisional ballot** at your polling place. A provisional vote will be counted once it is verified that you did not cast the mail-in ballot.

All mail-in ballots must be returned to the Denver Elections Division no later than 7 p.m. on Election Day for the ballot to be counted

HOW TO CONTACT PUBLIC OFFICIALS

When writing elected or appointed public officials:

1. Check spelling of official's name and exact title of office.
2. Describe the bill by its number or by its popular name.
3. Organize your facts and present a concise statement of the reasons for your position.
4. Include your name and address.
5. Time the letter to arrive when the issue is current. Email is best. US mail may take weeks to arrive in Washington.
6. Write letters of commendation when the official has done something of which you particularly approve.
